United for ALICE is launching in Minnesota as we become the 32nd state to become a partner state in order to share the story of ALICE.

Who is ALICE? ALICE is an acronym for Asset Limited, Income Restrained, Employed. ALICE is the people in our community that are working but barely able to make ends meet.

MCUW is partnering with Lakes Area United Way to launch this information in our region. Thanks to a grant from Sourcewell we will have \$35,000 to get staff trained on the data, market the information and identify and then work with parties in our region that would benefit from this information. United for ALICE will launch statewide in September. We hope to use this data to help the ALICE population within our communities.
